## Good Advice!!

---

The next time you order checks, have only your initials and last name put on them. If someone takes your checkbook, they will not know if you sign your checks with just your initials or your first name, but your credit union will know how you sign your checks. Don't sign the back of

your credit cards. Instead write "PHOTO ID REQUIRED"

When you are writing checks to pay on your credit card accounts, DO NOT put the complete account number on the "For" line. Instead, just put the last four numbers. The credit card company knows the rest of the number, and any-

one who might be handling your check as it passes through all the check processing channels will not have access to it.

These are just a few tips on how to help keep your account information safe.
