All proceeds from Six Flags and Hurricane Harbor ticket sales will go to Relay for Life.

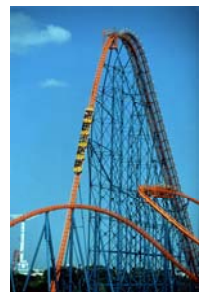
