Change of Address Policy Change

In an effort to maintain correct addresses on all of our members, and prevent your personal information and statements from going to obsolete addresses, we have adopted the following policy changes effective August 1, 2009:

All address change information must be in writing and

We will use any phone number or email address we have on file for you. We will try to contact you at work if possible. If we are unable to contact you in any
